










Choral Workshop: Sing Gloria 2016

The **Sing Gloria 2016** workshop will be held at St Mary's Northchurch on Saturday July 23rd. Our musical

director will be local choral director, composer and pianist Richard Grylls and our accompanist will be Ken Martlew, formerly musical director of St Mary's Hemel Hempstead. These two capable musicians will guide the massed choir in exploring, hopefully perfecting and then performing Vivaldi's Gloria in D, the Easter Hymn from Mascagni's opera Cavalleria Rusticana and Parry's magnificent anthem 'I was glad'. A number of other works will be explored during the workshop and if deemed worthy will supplement the main choral works at the evening 'performance' to family, friends and other supporters.

Timings: Doors will open at 1.00pm and the workshop will run from 1.30-5.30pm including breaks. At 6.30pm there will be an informal concert open to families and friends. The cost of the workshop is £15 per person, which includes all music hire, afternoon refreshments and supper. Accompanied children and students may attend the workshop FREE but please do book in the normal way. For those attending the

1914

1st Hertfordshire Regiment **Private 2401 Lionel MORGAN** Died 12th June 1916

Lionel Morgan moved Northchurch as a young boy when his father started work as a labourer at Norcott Hill Farm. THE GREAT WAR When he was 18 Lionel enlisted 1918 with 1st Battalion, Hertfordshire Regiment, a Territorial unit, and

was enjoying his first Annual Camp in Ashridge when war broke out in August 1914. At this time, no Territorials could be compelled to serve overseas, but they could volunteer and if more than 80% of a unit volunteered, and they proved their proficiency, they could go as a unit. Lionel and most of his unit volunteered and he was sent to France the following November.

Lionel saw action during the First Battle of Ypres later that month the battle that stopped the Germans reaching the Channel Ports. The following year he took part in the Battle

of Loos during which chlorine gas was used by the British for the first time.

Lionel was to remain the in the same area for the next few months alternating time in the trenches with rest period in billets or training around the town of Bethune.

On 9th June 1916, three days after returning to the front line, Lionel was admitted to No33 Casualty Clearing Station at Bethune with serious wounds, probably caused by artillery fire. Three days later he received Holy Communion from the Hospital Chaplain and passed away peacefully at about 10.00. Lionel's burial took place at the Bethune Town Cemetery the following day.

Seven weeks later, Lionel's elder brother Edwin, who was in France with 2nd Battalion, Bedfordshire Regiment, was to die during the Battle of the Somme.

Some Christians talk a lot about sin and non-Christians tend to think that this is a rather negative way of thinking about individual behaviour. There are sins of omission (not doing the good that you could) and sins of commission (where you deliberately do bad things to seemingly benefit yourself). The Apostle Paul gives lists of the second kind of sin: 'immorality, covetousness, idolatry, reviling, drunkenness, swindling' (I Corinthians 5, vs.10-11); his list in Galatians 5, vs.19-21 adds 'impurity, sensuality, sorcery, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, disputes, dissensions, factions, envyings, carousings', and he goes on 'those who practise such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God' and 'such were some of you, but you were washed and justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and the Spirit of our God' (1 Corinthians 6, vs.11)

Paul's aim was to get people to re-direct their lives along 'Jesus' lines with standards which enable God to forgive the sins which they will inevitably commit.

We don't earn a place in the Kingdom of God just by virtuous conduct, but we can lose a place if we are not covered by Paul's other list of what God does expect of us as representing evolving growth from our baptism into Christ onward. These positive qualities are described as the fruit of the Spirit and they comprise love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control (Galatians 5, vs.22-23). Progress in the qualities of this positive list can be pleasing to God and lead to a place in his kingdom.


